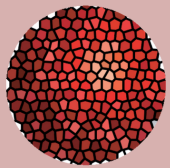

What's a clinical trial?

Clinical trials are research studies aimed at evaluating the safety and efficacy (effectiveness) of a new medical, surgical, or behavioral therapy or intervention.

Who can participate in a clinical trial?

Each study has its own criteria for who can and cannot participate. This is known as "eligibility." Eligibility may be based on many different components like age, gender, overall health, type & stage of a disease or condition, and more. Participation in a clinical trial is voluntary.

Should I participate in a clinical trial?

The only person who can answer this question is you! Participating does come with potential risks, but it may provide an opportunity to improve your health. You may also have all or part of your medical care paid for by the study sponsors. Your participation may help future generations facing the same condition as you. Learn as much as you can about a study and don't be afraid to ask the research team questions.
